

**THE BROACH APPROACH  
BEADING WORKSHOP**

Learn the basics of bead embroidery and come home with a lovely beaded broach!

**Description :**

“The Broach Approach” workshop is appropriate for people new to beading. In this workshop you will be introduced to beading supplies, materials, and a number of bead embroidery techniques. You will be shown finishing techniques and come away with a strong foundation in bead embroidery. Participants would come away well on their way to finishing a broach.
